Please follow the Costume Instructions listed below:

1. Please **try on** all costumes at home ASAP. Put your name on all costume pieces. Call the studio if you have any questions.
2. **Hang-up** costumes in a plastic bag and place costume accessories in a zip-loc bag attached to the main costume bag and store in a **SAFE** place.
3. **DO NOT IRON COSTUMES.**
4. **DO NOT DRY CLEAN COSTUMES.**
5. Put **Names /Initials** in all costume pieces so they do not get misplaced or lost at the recital.

If costumes or costume pieces are lost or damaged, they will not be able to be replaced. **DO NOT LOSE YOUR COSTUME!!**
